SNAP (Food Stamp) Application Support

As part of a new program, CSC volunteers and staff will hold "office hours" to help answer questions about food stamps, assist with applications, other food stamp related questions, and connections to community resources.

Our current hours, which we plan on expanding, are: Monday, 1-6 p.m. (Front office)
Tuesday: 1-4 p.m. (Resource office)
Wednesday 11 a.m.-Noon (Front office) 1-3:30 p.m. (Resource office)
Friday, 2-4:30 p.m. (Front office)

Starting January 1, 2017, able-bodied adults without dependents in Clackamas County will have food stamp privileges limited. To find out more information or learn about possible exemptions to this rule, you can visit us during office hours.
