

Donation Requests during COVID-19

We are asking for your support at this time because our food and hygiene requests are at an alltime high. At Clackamas Service Center, our core food services endure, as we pack and deliver food boxes to families and individuals in need, and continue to serve to-go meals to our houseless clients.

Funds donated right now will increase our food purchasing power, and cover the additional costs of cleaning supplies, to-go containers, gas for our delivery drivers, hazard pay for our frontline workers, and regular expenses and bills.

We are also asking for help from the public with a few specific in-kind items.

HIGH NEED ITEMS (updated 5/14/20)

- bottled water & small electrolyte drinks
- canned/pouch tuna, pasta, cold cereal, small jars of peanut butter, fruit cups, protein bars,
 canned chili or stew, canned fruit, other small snack items pop-tops are best for canned items
- tarps new or gently used, especially 8x10 or similar sizes
- men's jeans or sweatpants, especially waist sizes 30-34
- women's jeans, leggings or sweatpants, especially sizes 6-12
- adult t-shirts, hoodies, and jackets
- individually packaged toothbrushes & toothpaste
- shampoo, conditioner, body wash, bar soap, deodorant
- dish soap & other household cleaners
- **phone chargers**, especially older Android and iPhone chargers
